TROLLEY WRECK INQUIRY.

Newark Board of Trade Committee- man Arraigns Traction Officials.

NEWARK, Feb. 24.—The special committee appointed by the Board of Trade to investigate the cause of last Thursday's trolley wreck at the Clifton Avenue grade crossing, submitted its report to the Grand Jury this afternoon with an urgent request that immediate action be taken by that body.

At a meeting of the Board of Trade this morning a communication from E. F. Hartshorn, a member of the committee, was read. The letter severely arraigns the North Jersey Traction Company for alleged negligence and indicates that certain officials of that company may be held responsible by the committee.

The Coroner's jury will begin an investigation of the wreck to-morrow morning.

The high school opened this morning for the first day since the accident, when about 90 per cent. of the scholars responded to their names. But few of the children rode over the Clifton Avenue trolley line.
